

About Us

Without the cultivation of education no society can exist for long.

Some academically interested persons of Panikhali, Nadia and its nearby areas were in a motto to establish a Govt. Aided General Degree College at Panikhali. After many sacrifices and communication, finally on 15th June, 2007 they had succeeded in establishing 'Pritilata Mahila Mahavidyalaya' for the education of the girl students by getting the affiliation from University of Kalyani.

The College is named after Pritilata Waddedar (1911 – 1932), a Bengali revolutionary nationalist who dedicated her life at the age of 21 for the freedom movement of the nation. The brave lady is an ideal, a beacon of light for women. Inspired by the ideals of this distinguished lady, the initial mission of the College was to encourage the empowerment of women only through higher

education and social consciousness. Thus, the College was named as 'Pritilata Waddedar Mahavidyalaya'. But the idealism and dedication of this patriotic young woman for the Indian independence movement is not limited for the inspiration of women only. She was a vast ray of light for the transformation of all.

In 2011, the status of the College was changed to Co-educational and the name of the College was changed to 'Pritilata Waddedar Mahavidyalaya'. The motto, dream and duty of us are stated in the logo of the College – we are to distribute the light of education and culture to society. Our mission is to flourish in the academic field by providing quality education, comprehending the training of the mind, heart and body and to encourage the empowerment of all types of students (boys, girls and trans-gendered), so that they can establish their opinion with authority and position.

The College began its journey in the initial years with 85 students and guest teachers in Bengali, English, History, Political Science and Philosophy. In 2011, the first appointments to substantive posts in non-teaching positions were made and in 2013-2014 the College obtained permission to start Honours courses in Bengali and History. In 2014 the College got its first Assistant Professors in Political Science and Bengali and in August, 2015 the College had its first Principal in Dr. Baby Dey (Mitra). In 2016 – 2017, the College had two more Assistant Professors in Philosophy and English and in 2021, Assistant Professor in History joined the Institution. Today, our College runs its academic activities

through five Assistant Professors, twelve State Aided College Teachers (SACT) under the inspirational guidance of the Teacher-in-Charge.

Established in 2007, Pritilata Waddedar Mahavidyalaya (formerly Pritilata Mahavidyalaya) is presently a co-educational General Degree college offering courses in BA in both Honours and General streams and is situated in Ranaghat – II Development Block of Nadia District. Named after Pritilata Waddedar, one of the foremost revolutionaries in our freedom struggle, the institution seeks to cultivate elevated human values, dignity of living, social and national service and academic excellence among its learners.

From the academic session 2023-2024, the College is offering under the NEP-2020, 4 - Year Undergraduate Curriculum, with Major and Minor courses in Bengali, English, History, Education, Political Science, Philosophy, Physical Education and an additional Minor course in Sanskrit. Earlier to this the College followed Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) curriculum, offering Honours courses in Bengali, English, History and Education, and General Degree courses in subjects – Bengali, English, History, Education, Political Science, Philosophy, Physical Education and Sanskrit.

The curriculum followed is the recommended curriculum of the affiliating University of Kalyani.

The College is also a distinguished study centre under Open and Distance

Learning Centre of the University of Kalyani, offering Post-graduate guidance
to learners pursuing MA courses in Bengali, English, History and Education.

Beyond academic activities, the College has an active social outreach mission through its National Service Scheme (NSS) unit whose constructive work has had a transformational effect in the suburbs of Panikhali and surrounding areas.

Another important focus of activity of the College surrounds the Physical Education department, its dedicated gymnasium and an adequate playground, which has been making a transformative contribution to the learners in the past and continues to do so today.

Collaboration: The College is aware of the needs of its learners to develop into citizens of tomorrow with adequate exposure to the social, cultural and service focused institutions. Keeping this requirement in mind, the College has made collaborative memoranda of understanding with Colleges such as Srikrishna College, Bagula; Nabadwip Vidyasagar College; Kabi Nazrul College, Birbhum; Chapra Bangaljhi College; social service institutions such as Sreema Mahila Samity, Duttapulia, Nadia; neighbourhood schools such as Jugal Kishore S S Shikshayatan (HS), Bankimnagar Adarsha Vidyapith; vocational training and placement group such as Bandhan – Konnagar. The College desires to expand such collaborative efforts to enhance the exposure of our students to a wide spectrum of social and vocational spheres of modern day living.

Commitment for the Environment: The College is situated in the lush green environment of a rural background in Ranaghat – II Development Block and is actively in pursuit of environment friendly activities with the motto of reducing carbon footprint and adopting environment-friendly practices. The College has been maintaining a well-curated garden with a wide-variety of plants in its campus. Also, the West Bengal Renewal Energy Development Agency (WBREDA) has installed a rooftop, grid-integrated Solar Photo-voltaic panel with the purpose of harnessing solar energy for fruitful, environmentally friendly use.

True to our motto, we are steadfast in our mission to distribute the light of education, learning and culture to the society for the development of the country and for this we have miles to go.


